

Sir Knights,

There have been a number of events that have taken place since our last edition of the Encyclical.

The Assembly hosted a Valentine's Dinner Dance on Friday February 12th at Delaney Council. Everyone had a great time and the people who attended were very generous to the Assembly. We had 58 attendees who, through the various raffles - 50/50, Valentines Baskets and TV Raffle, helped us raise almost \$1,200 that will go towards our Veteran Support Program. In addition, at the dance, we raised \$320 that we gave to Fr. Rudy, our Faithful Friar, to help with his recovery from a fire at the St. Anne's Rectory a few months ago. Thank You for your generosity.





On February 16th we lost a great man and priest, Msgr. Tom Hartman. If you ever wondered how Fr. McGivney would have benefited from today's TV, Radio and Social Media, you just have to look at the life and good works of Msgr. Tom. For Msgr. Tom Hartman's Mass of Transferal, our Assembly was the host Assembly and organized the Color Corps Turnout, Msgr. was a member of our Assembly for 42 years. All Nassau Assemblies turned out for this mass and it was the largest turnout of Guardsmen in a very long time; 54 guardsmen attended. From Msgr. Tom's coffin in front of the altar to the back doors of St. Aidan's Church it was a sea of red capes. Everyone was very

thankful and impressed by the Knights of Columbus tribute to Msgr. Tom.

This year the Assembly is concentrating on the many Veteran Groups that service the Long Island area. At our February meeting at Delaney Council, we had a special guests from America's VetDogs Organization. A presentation described the great work this organization does with Veterans who require 'Comfort' dogs to help them with recovery from the battlefields. These dogs help Veterans from World War II through the current conflicts in Iraq and Afghanistan. This was one of the most attended meetings we had in a long time. The Assembly presented a donation to VetDogs at the meeting. The attendees were so impressed with what they heard, they donated another \$185 to help them in




COLOR CORPS





The Color Corps is an ELECTIVE division of the Fourth Degree, whose distinctive presence in parades, wreath-laying ceremonies, Confirmations and other Catholic functions is a visible reminder of our service to the community. The tuxedo, chapeau, cape and sword worn

by the Color Corps were inspired by 19th century naval uniforms, with different cape colors representing nine different program ranks. The ceremonial sword symbolizes Christian Knighthood, and is carried to signify reverence to Church, Eucharist, country and freedom.



When knighthood was in flower, knights carried the sword to defend their God, their Church, their country and their fellow man according to the code of chivalry. Today, Sir Knights wear regalia and carry the sword to honor Christ and His apostles, especially on religious and civic occasions. Hence,

the primary purpose of the Fourth Degree is to encourage active Catholic citizenship and foster the spirit of patriotism in members and the community at large.



The Fourth Degree Color Corps is the most visible part of the Knights of Columbus. The Color Corps provides Honor Guard services at church functions such as Confirmations and wakes/funerals of Knights, and provides a public affirmation of Catholic Citizenship in parades, Special Olympics events

and other events.

Any Fourth Degree Sir Knight is eligible to join the Color Corps ranks.

Color Corps News

The Saint John XXIII Assembly Color Corps makes every effort to accommodate all turnout requests sent to the Faithful Navigator or Commander. We have very dedicated Guardsmen who make every effort to turn out for any request from an Assembly Council. Unfortunately we are now at a point where this dedication is being taken for granted and we have to struggle to maintain our commitment to make turnout requests.

We have many councils who never attend an Assembly Meeting or an Assembly event such as a dance. Just as important, they have no Council Members who are part of the Color Corps or maybe just one member. These same councils then expect the Faithful Navigator and Commander to ensure that all of their turnout requests are honored. In some cases, when we cannot honor a request, a complaint is made that the Assembly did not honor their turnout commitment.

Over the past couple of years it has become more of a trend for one night wake services. This has put pressure on the Color Corps to turn out for every wake. We sometimes get only a one day notice for a wake service. The word goes out to the guardsmen and we can usually put together a squad for the Sir Knight's wake. If we have already committed to another wake service or a turnout for a mass, etc.; we have to try and split a squad and if that is not possible we have to turn down the second request or find another Assembly to help us so the second request is honored.

This is not acceptable, but it is now a fact that these situations will continue to come up and we may have to disappoint a council by not being able to honor a turnout request. Since we make every effort to honor requests, many of our guardsmen will pull double duty in order to not deny a request. Recently we had a request for a Memorial Mass at a Council for 9 AM on a Sunday. Saturday afternoon we received a wake request for a one night service on Sunday evening at 7:30 PM. Due to the dedication of our Color Corps members, both turnout requests were honored with the same guardsmen turning out for the Mass and the Wake on the same day.

We need to come up with a solution for these situations. We have many guardsmen who can only turnout on a semi-regular basis due to illness, family, work and other factors.

Every Grand Knight and Fourth Degree Chairman of our Assembly Councils need to bring up joining the Color Corps and getting involved with the Assembly at their business meetings. We have very few councils that have guardsmen in the Color Corps. We need every Council to begin a recruitment drive and have at a minimum, two council members who are members of the Color Corps. If this is not done soon, we have no choice but to begin turning down requests. We no longer have the man power to maintain our commitment to make every turnout request. It is up to our Councils, not just the Assembly, to make sure turnout requests are always honored by recruiting their members to become Guardsmen.

Delaney Council just had one of their members join the Color Corps. We welcome SK Robert Coyne, PGK, PFN as a member of the Saint John XXIII Color Corps. I hope to be able to make the same announcements soon from other Councils.


EVERY VETERAN DESERVES A PROPER BURIAL.
